

## **Annual Report 2019-20**

Al Ameen public school, Sreemoolanagaram has marched past 18 mile stones. The climb has been arduous but steady, the will has been unrelenting. All these years our school tried to retain its identity creating a unique culture of its own infusing values into a progressive approach. The carefully crafted success story of this institution consists of many factors. Teamwork and commitment of its teaching and non teaching staff, dedication of its students, unstinted support and cooperation of the parents. But the main secret of our success is the farsightedness, conviction and high standard of excellence set by our manager supported by Al Ameen educational trust.

As in the past, this academic year also our students of class 10 and 12 has come out successful in flying colours in the CBSE board examinations with 100% results. In class X out of 70 students appeared, 12 students got more than 90% marks in all subjects, 60 students got distinction and the remaining 10 students got first class. One student Ina Wilson got full A+ in all subjects.

In class XII out of 30 students appeared, 17 students got distinction and the rest of them got first class except one. Joel M Tom stood first in the Science group whereas Muhammed Raziq was the topper in the Commerce stream.

Our school has been selected for the justice V. Khalid memorial award for institutional excellence – 2019 instituted by PM foundation for the creditable performance of our school with cent percent pass in class X CBSE examination held in the year 2019. This award will be presented on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of This month.

Our school had also received the Aksharatheeram Award instituted by the MLA of Aluva constituency for getting 100% results in the CBSE examinations.

In the field of non academic areas also the achievement of our students were remarkable.

- In the inter school news reading competition held at Amal public school in which more than 22 schools participated, Hiba fathima of class X got first prize. She got a trophy, certificate and a cash prize of 1000/- rupees.
- In the freedom quest – 2019 held at Al Ameen public school, Edappilly, our students had won a number of prizes.

- In the inter school cultural fest ‘ Vista’ held at Rajagiri Public School, Kalamassery, our boys had won first prize in mime.
- In the interschool Karate competition held at Peace international school, Paravur our school had won the second runners up trophy.
- In the National Karate competition held at Kannur one of our students Al Asbin got third prize and bronze medal.
- In the inter Al Ameen throw ball tournament held in our school, our girls had won the ever rolling trophy for the third consecutive year.
- In the Rajagiri Christhujayathi Inter school football tournament in which 18 schools participated, our boys had reached upto semi finals.
- Our students had participated in many competitive examinations like VVM - Vidhyarthi Vighyan Manthan examination, Aryabhata Ganit challenge examination, Chandrayan space quiz all conducted by the govt. of India and NCERT.
- In the VVM examination two of our students Ananyasree and Anna Joy of class IX got selected to the state level camp. Of these two students Ananyasree got third rank in the district rankers from the senior group.
- In the Aryabhata Ganit Challenge, 3 of our students Fathima Parvin, Arjun, Alan James Joy were qualified for the next level of examination, the result of which is not yet known.
- In the CBSE science exhibition of the Trivandrum region which was held at Saraswati Vidhya Nikethan, Elamakkara, two of our students Ananyasree and Irfana demonstrated their innovative skill through an eco friendly project.
- The prime minister of India had launched the fit India movement to bring about behavioural changes among students and make them physically active. As instructed by the ministry of youth affairs, govt. of India, we had registered our self online along with the details of the activities done in our school and we got the fit India certificate of recognition and fit India flag.
- On the reopening day itself the Environmental day was celebrated. We had received different kinds of saplings from the forest department which were distributed among students and a pretty good numbers were planted in our campus itself.
- On 21<sup>st</sup> June the International Yoga day was observed with a class by a Yoga Guru followed by yoga demonstration by our boys and girls. Slogan writing, essay writing and drawing competitions were held in connection with the yoga day.
- Election to the school cabinet was held on 27<sup>th</sup> June in which Athul P.S. of class X was elected as the Head boy and Hiba Fathima of class X was

elected as the Head girl. The sports captain, vice captain and prefects and assistant prefects of the four houses were also elected on the same day.

- The investiture ceremony was held on the 10<sup>th</sup> of July in which our manager Mr. Faisal Khader handed over the badges and scrolls to the elected leaders.
- In the month of June itself two of our students Pavan Raju and Rohith Krishna attended the two day Atal Tinkering Fest held at Toch public school, Vyttila.
- On the Independence Day the national flag was hoisted by our manager followed by a small program arousing patriotism.
- Onam was celebrated with great pomp and show. Floral carpet competition, tug of war, thiruvathira, pulikali and onappattukal were the highlights of the day followed by payasam distribution.
- On 4<sup>th</sup> September 29 students of our school attended a programme 'Project samritan' organised by Rotary club Kochi in collaboration with VPS Lakeshore Hospital in which the students were given audio visual classes on road safety and hands on training on how to deal with emergency situations and cardio pulmonary resuscitation
- In order to make our students nature friendly and create awareness about the importance of agriculture we took our students to participate in the harvest festival organized by the Krishibhavan.
- The school youth festival "Mazhavillu" was held on 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> of August in which the Homi Babha house stood first with 231 points followed by CV Raman house with 200 points.
- In connection with the 150<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi a week long programme was organised in our school like cleaning the school campus, allfaith prayers, skit on Gandhiji's life, essay writing competition etc.
- On 1<sup>st</sup> November the Kerala Piravi day was celebrated in a colourful manner.
- On 11<sup>th</sup> November about 130 students of our school attended a Mega CPR training program organized by Indian medical association and Kelsa at Cial convention centre, Nedumbassery.
- The children's day was celebrated on 14<sup>th</sup> November with many colourful programs by the KG and primary class children.
- The annual sports day of the school was held on 21<sup>st</sup> November. Mr. Ubaid K.H, an international athlete and marathon runner was the guest of honour. The march past of the four houses and colourful display of KG and primary students were the highlights of the day. In sports CV Raman house bagged the winner's trophy and Homi Bhaba house became the runners up.

- In the inter house manuscript competition Aakar of Vikram Sarabhai house got the first prize with 824 points and Zenith of J C bose house got the second prize with 820 points. The Homi Bhaba house is adjudged as the best house with 1902 points followed by Vikram Sarabhai house with 765 points. Congratulations to the house mistresses, teachers, house prefects and students of these two houses.
- As a part of tours and travels students of different classes were taken to different places. The senior students were taken to Udupi and Chikamangalur where as the lower classes were taken to Ooty, Munnar, dream world etc.
- As a part of health check up, an eye check up was conducted for all the students of our school by Kochi eye care center.
- On 15<sup>th</sup> June a class on drug abuse was arranged for students. Mr. Abdul Jamal, who is a police officer gave an awareness class.
- A motivational class for both students and parents were conducted separately. Dr. T.O. Poulouse was the resource person.
