Re opening of the school, for the academic session 2022-23

Al Ameen campus became active and alive with the cheerful presence of Al Ameenians on 1st June 2022. The new PRE KG & LKG students were welcomed to the world of education and knowledge in a very festive mood on 6th June.

SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENTS

Our student's outstanding performance in the CBSE Board Examination has brought optimum glory to our school by scoring 100% pass in both X & XII Examinations. In class X, out of 44 students appeared, 31 students got Distinction and remaining 13 got First Class. Kum. Teresa M stood first with 97% and Kum. Aliya Abdul Jabbar Scored 100 out of 100 in Malayalam.

In class XII out of 22 students, 17 students got First Class. Kum. Nihala Basheer got full A1 in all subjects. Kum.Hiba Fathima stood first in Science group with 96% whereas Mariya Saju was topper in Commerce stream.

Our school has received the Alive Award instituted by MLA of Aluva constituency for getting 100% result in Board Examination.

We also received KMM Merit Award instituted by KMM collages for achieving 100% pass in Higher Secondary Examination 2022

School Parliament Election and Investiture Ceremony

For the selection of skilled and qualified leaders Meet the Candidate Session was organized on 23rd June. The School Election was held on 29th June wherein the students of class V to XII casted their votes through ballot system. Master. Muhammad Afzal T N of class X and Kumari. Athira Suresh Menon of class X was elected as Head Boy & Head Girl. The Sports Captain , Sports Vice captain, House Prefects and Assistant House Prefects of the four Housesie:- C V Raman House, HomiBhaba House, J C Bose House and Vikram Sarabhai House were also elected on the same day.

The Investiture Ceremony was held on 24th August in which our Manager Mr. Faizal Khader T handed over the badges and scrolls to the elected leaders.

Kalotsav 2022

In order to tap the hidden talents of our students and show case their talents, our school provides various opportunities every year. This year, school level arts fest "RAINBOW 2022" was held on 16th& 17th of September was officially inaugurated by Mr. Faizal Khader T, our school manager. It was conducted house wise and winners are awarded with trophies & certificates. Along with this, every day we are conducting assembly for the students of class IV to XII. On class wise and various opportunities are being provided to them to develop and exhibiting their talents. The Vikram Sarabhai House is adjudged as the best house with 243 points followed by C V Raman House with 180 points.

On November 11th, 12th and 13th, 135 students of our school participated in the CBSE Metro Sahodaya Kalotsav held at Sree Sarada Vidyalaya Kalady. We secured 468 points and stood in 5th position out of 62 schools. Our students won 1st prize in English Recitation, Oppana, Kolkali and Malayalam Essay writing and 2nd prize in Hindi Elocution, Hindi Recitation, Arabic Recitation, Hindi Extempore, group dance in Category II, Mappilappattu, Painting with water colour, Mime and Duffmuttu and 3rd prize in Cartoon, Kuchipudi, Painting with oil colour, Arabic Recitation, Mappilappattu, Versification Malayalam and Patriotic Song. Kum. Ain V S of class III became the Kalathilakam of Category I.

35 students participated in State CBSE Kalotsav held at Carmel Public School Vazhakulam in the month of November and secured A grade in most of the items they participated.

Sports and games

The Sports department organized a series of inter house indoor and outdoor events throughout the year. Mini Sports Day was conducted on 18th November. School Sports Meet held on 23rd November was declared by Mr. Shefeeque, famous Zumba Instructor. In sports Vikram Sarabhai House with 510 points bagged the winner's trophy and HomiBhaba House with 422 points became the Runner up.

73 athletes from our school participated in Inter Al Ameen Athletic Meet held at Al Ameen Inter National Public School Edathala on 30th November & 1st December. We won the Second Overall Runner up trophy. Under 12 category Kum. Raiza Fathima won the individual champion and Under 14 category Kum. Sivananda V P became the individual champion.

In All Kerala CBSE Football Tournament "Redeem Cup" held at Aluva on 27th August, our team won the Runner up in under 12 category. Master. Affan Ashraf got the Best Player trophy and Master. Muhammed Aamir got the Best Defender.

Our under 19 category team participated in CBSE Inter School Football Tournament "Delta Cup" held at Thoppumpady on 31st August. They also participated in Santa Maria Cup held at Fort Kochi on 22nd September.

In Inter school Football Tournament held at ChavaraDarsan CMI School Koonammavu, our under 12 category team became the winners. Master. Affan Ashraf got the Best Player Award and Master. Arnav Rajesh got Best Goal Award.

In Inter School Football Tournament held at Georgian Public School in under 19 category, Master. Ahmed Mishal got the Man of the match Award.

In the history of Al Ameen, Girls Football team played MGM Inter School Soccer Cup and reached till Semi Final.

In Inter Al Ameen Football Tournament held at Al Ameen Public School Chandiroor, our team won the Runner up trophy in under 15 category.

For the first time, our girls Kho Kho team participated in Inter School Kho Kho tournament held at RajagiriChristu Jayanthi School Kakkanad and won their 1st game.

As part of FIFAWORLD CUP 2022, our school conducted inter house football tournament for boys & girls on 14th November.

Teachers Empowerment programmes and training

Teacher orientation programmes are held in regular basis at our school and the teachers are taking keen interest in attending the capacity building programme conducted by CBSE on various topics. Almost all the teachers attended the mandatory trainings session as per the affiliation bye laws of CBSE. Our teachers attended above 800 Capacity Building Programme as per CBSE bye laws.

Childrens day was an event where the whole KG students participated on 14th November.
